**TO: ALL PLAN HOLDERS**

This Addendum No. 1 to the Contract Documents for City of Winter Springs project "The Ranchlands Roadway Improvements – Phase I" is hereby declared a part of the original Contract Documents dated November 2009, and in the case of conflict, the following Addendum No. 1 shall govern. **Bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum on the Bid Form.**

Project Manual:

1. Section 00300 – Bid Form:

Delete Section 00300 (3 pages) and replace with Section 00300 (3 pages) attached hereto and annotated as "ADDENDUM No. 1".

The changes to Section 00300 are summarized as follows:

- a. Changed quantities of 8" and 12" HDPE Drainage Pipe
- b. Added a line for the Bidder to identify which of the three roadway base options was selected

Drawings:

1. Sheet 6:

Add the following note: "Install 30 LF of 8-inch HDPE Drainage Pipe at the driveway at 160 East Bahama Road, approx. STA. 21+60"

Clarifications:

1. **Question:** "Is an arbor permit required for the tree removals?"

**Response:** Yes. The contractor shall apply for and obtain an arbor permit from the City of Winter Springs. There is no fee for the permit. The contractor performing the removals must have an arbor license issued by the City, which can be obtained for \$44 at the contractor's expense.

2. **Question:** "Is seeding acceptable in place of sodding?"

**Response:** No. Pay item 570-1-2 "Performance Turf" shall be sod only (no seeding).

3. **Question:** “On Sheet D-1, for the driveway details, is wire reinforcement required in addition to the fibermesh?”

**Response:** No wire reinforcement is required. Fibermesh is required in all driveway concrete.
