- 1. Complete the banner permit application in full.
- 2. Provide copies of banner location and what banner will look like.

The banner permit is reviewed by Land Development and takes three to five days to process.

Sec. 16-87. - Banners.

A maximum of one (1) on-premises banner sign may be erected on commercial, industrial, or multi-family zoned property provided that the banner does not exceed sixty-four (64) square feet and is not erected for more than forty-five (45) calendar days during any one calendar year. A maximum of one (1) on-premises banner sign may be erected on property zoned residential provided the banner does not exceed twenty-four (24) square feet and is not erected for more than three (3) calendar days during anyone calendar year. With respect to property zoned Town Center, the size and time requirements set forth in this section shall be determined based on whether the property is being used or permitted for commercial, multi-family, or residential purposes, with vacant, un-permitted property within the Town Center being treated as commercial. All banner signs shall be securely fastened to a structure in a manner to withstand weather elements commonly experienced by the city.
