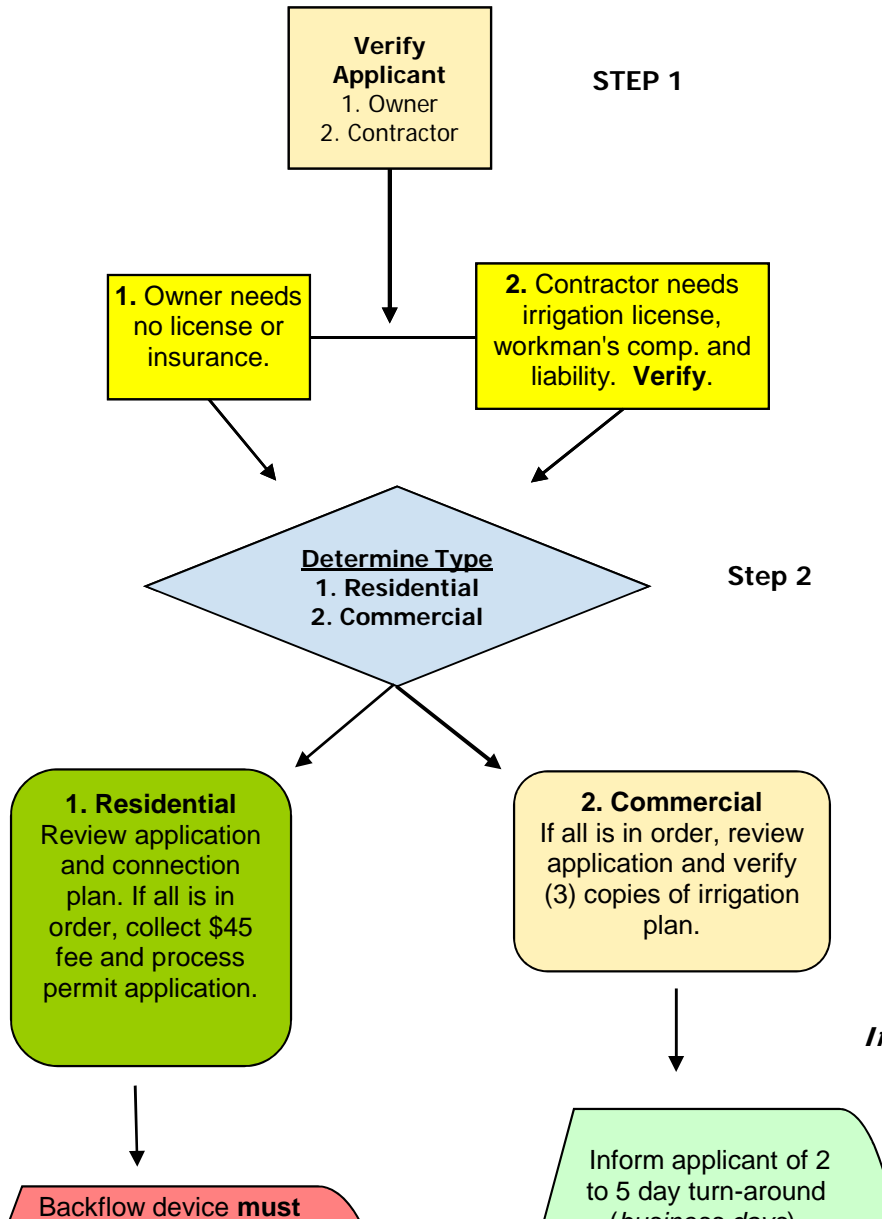


Irrigation Permits



1. A **residential** irrigation permit is defined as a single family dwelling (non-developer) permit for installation or connection of an irrigation system by the owner or a licensed irrigation contractor. Fee \$45.00 per permit.

2. A **commercial** irrigation permit is defined as a developer or contractor (of multi family, retail, commercial, municipal, industrial, or a residential subdivision common area) permit for installation or connection of an irrigation system(s). Fee \$150.00 per permit.

STEP 3

If no, do not accept application until complete.

be connected by a **licensed plumber or irrigation contractor.**
The Public Works Utility office must be contacted for an inspection of the backflow device and connection.

(business days).
Pass application package to *Urban Beautification* for review. If plans meet requirements, **approval** will be given to issue permit.
At issuance, collect \$150 fee.

STEP 4

A request for an inspection by the resident of the backflow device and connection to be called in via the **inspection line**, then relayed to Public Works by the C.D.D. customer service division for **Inspection.**

Issue permit to applicant. Inform that inspection will be required at **50%** (with trenched open in areas) and again at **100% completion.**
Inspections **must** be called into the **inspection line.**

STEP 5

Pass or fail inspection.

Pass package back to *Urban Beautification* for inspections. Once completed, the package will be returned to the Customer Service file by *Urban Beautification.*
