



During the month of August 2015, the following Resolutions, Contracts, and Agreements, were approved by the City of Winter Springs City Commission:

Resolutions:

- The City Commission approved Resolution 2015-14 authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs Cultural Facilities Program for use on the Magnolia Park Amphitheater.
- The City Commission approved Resolution 2015-17 authorizing the submission of the Certificates to Non-Ad Valorem Assessment Roll, Assessment Summary and FY 2015-2016 Annual Assessment Roll for Tax Year 2015 relating to the Oak Forest Assessment Areas, the Tusawilla Assessment Areas – Phases I and II, and the Tusawilla Phase III Assessment Areas to the Seminole County Tax Collector.

Contracts/Agreements:

- The City Commission approved the renewal of the annual school resource officer inter-agency agreement with the Seminole County School Board.
- The City Commission approved entering into an agreement with N.S. Marine & Industrial Services Corporation for construction of concrete sidewalk and curb (cont'd)

Contracts/Agreements (continued):

replacement at various locations throughout the city.

- The City Commission approved McDirmit Davis, LLC. as the top ranked consultant for the City's external annual audit.
- The City Commission authorized the Utility Department to enter into a contract agreement with Rocha Controls of Tampa for the east water reclamation plant control system modifications and programming.
- The City Commission approved the Florida Avenue Streetscape Project agreement with the U.S. 17-92 Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) which authorizes CRA reimbursement funding to be used as partial payment for the Florida Avenue Streetscape Project.

Of Special Interest:

- The City Commission and the Parks and Recreation Department recognized campers from the Camp Sunshine Summer Camp program for outstanding character traits. The following children were recognized as award recipients: Sara Jimenez-Homes, Dana Jimenez-Homes, Dominic Dearolf, Hailey West, Jennifer Morales, Tristen Washington, and Natalie Cruz.
- The City Commission reviewed cost reduction alternatives for the Magnolia Park Amphitheater and directed staff to bring back a design proposal incorporating the selected cost reduction alternatives.
- The City Commission approved utilizing Neptune Technology Group Inc. for the purchase of water meter reading equipment, software, and maintenance.

Feeling the sting of mosquitoes?



Then it's time to:

**DRAIN
AND
COVER**

A collection of blue and white icons representing mosquito prevention: a blue bucket with water being poured, a pair of blue pants, a white shirt, a blue bottle of repellent, and a blue house with a white screen on the door.

Stop mosquitoes
from living and multiplying around your home or business.
Protect yourself
from mosquito bites and the diseases they carry.

DRAIN STANDING WATER.

DRAIN: Garbage cans, house gutters, pool covers, coolers, toys, flower pots or any other containers where sprinkler or rain water has collected.

DISCARD: Old tires, drums, bottles, cans, pots and pans, broken appliances and other items that aren't being used.

EMPTY AND CLEAN: Birdbaths and pets' water bowls at least once or twice a week.

PROTECT: Boats and vehicles from rain with tarps that don't accumulate water.

MAINTAIN: The water balance (pool chemistry) of swimming pools. Empty plastic swimming pools when not in use.

COVER YOUR SKIN.

CLOTHING: If you must be outside when mosquitoes are active, cover up. Wear shoes, socks, long pants, and long sleeves.

REPELLENT: Apply mosquito repellent to bare skin and clothing. Always use repellents according to the label. Repellents with DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus, and IR3535 are effective. Use mosquito netting to protect children younger than 2 months.

COVER DOORS AND WINDOWS WITH SCREENS. Keep mosquitoes out of your house. Repair broken screens on windows, doors, porches, and patios.




Active Projects




Cross Seminole Trail:

- The Cross Seminole Trail has a missing link from Layer Elementary to the west end of Old Sanford/Oviedo Road. The planned connection will continue from the current terminus at Layer and run northerly adjacent to SR 419. The City is working with the County and the State to facilitate the construction of this section of the trail.

Magnolia Park Amphitheater:

- The Magnolia Park Amphitheater is proposed to be constructed at the eastern end of Blumberg Blvd. Construction is anticipated to begin in early 2016 with completion in the fall of 2016.



Assisted Living Facility:

- The City is working with the Hawthorne Group for a proposed assisted living facility. The facility will consist of 144 units with congregative dining, and entertainment options.





CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE (Cont.)



Dunkin' Donuts:

- The multi-unit project is located at the S.E. corner of SR 434 and Stone Gable Circle. The facility opened Friday, September 25, 2015.



The Greens at Tusawilla:

- The 60 unit townhome project is located on Winter Springs Blvd. adjacent to the Tusawilla Country Club. The project is approximately 70% complete.



Jesup's Landing:

- The project consist of 171 townhomes in 30 building units on 17 acres of land located on the south side of Orange Ave., behind Winter Springs High School. Construction is ongoing and the project is approximately 65% complete.





CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE (Cont.)



Offices at Winding Hollow (West side):

- The Office complex has 4 of the 6 proposed buildings complete. The project is on hold while financial issues are resolved.



Opportunity Sites:

- Winter Springs offers excellent opportunities for the development of high technology industries. Situated on the eastern edge of the City, Seminole Way is a strategic economic development initiative focused on attracting high value jobs and businesses to Seminole County. The State Road 417 (Central Florida Greenway) corridor

defines the boundaries of the Seminole Way district, spanning the length of Seminole County and connecting to both Orange County's "Innovation Way" and the "Medical City" located at Lake Nona. The City has targeted this Greenway Interchange District (GID) for technology industry development complemented by commercial and retail establishments. It is expected to become a premier employment center with professional and high tech office buildings, conference facilities, and hotel rooms.



The GID opportunity site is comprised of 26 potential sites with over 378 acres. One of the key features of this opportunity site is the ease of assemblage: it offers the largest consolidation of vacant developable land within the City under the ownership of only 3 land owners.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE (Cont.)



Plante Property (Tuskawilla Crossing):

- The proposed project will include approximately 373 residential units comprised of traditional single family detached homes and detached bungalow units on lots ranging from 34ft. to 70ft. in width. In addition, the project will include a commercial component. Staff is working with the applicant on final modifications to the site design.

Pollack Shores Apartments:

- The project is approximately 300 units in the Winter Springs Town Center, located east of Tuskawilla Road. Staff is working with the developer's Engineer and Architect to finalize the project details. The engineering plans are currently being reviewed by staff.



The Professional Offices (East side):

- The Professional Offices will be located on the east side of Winding Hollow Boulevard and are proposed to be more upscale than the west side offices. The project is on hold while financial issues are resolved.





CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE (Cont.)



The RiZE at Winter Springs:

- This project is located east of City Hall in the Winter Springs Town Center. Construction on the residential units is underway. Occupancy of the first units is scheduled for January 2016.

Seven Oaks Subdivision:

- The project consist of 138 single-family units located on the south side of Shepard Road, north of Florida Avenue, east of Boat Lake, near the City's boundary on U.S. HWY 17-92. Construction of the residential units continues.



Southern Oaks Subdivision:

- The Southern Oaks subdivision, consist of a 50-acre development, with approximately 92 houses near the Oviedo and Winter Springs boundary along SR 434. Site work on the Winter Springs portion of the project is expected to commence in late 2015.
