Update of Federally Funded Transportation Projects in Winter Springs

The City of Winter Springs has received federal funding in the amount of up to \$812,000 to construct three transportation improvement projects under the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), which is more commonly referred to as the “Economic Stimulus Plan.” Construction contracts have been awarded to the lowest responsive bidder on all three projects, and construction started in December 2009 with completion by March 2010.

- **Construction of a Right-turn Deceleration Lane on S.R. 434 eastbound at Vistawilla Drive.**
This turn lane has also been warranted for several years and it will provide necessary safety and operational improvements at the S.R. 434 / Vistawilla Drive intersection.

- **Construction of a Right-turn Deceleration Lane on S.R. 434 Eastbound at Hayes Road**

This turn lane has been warranted for several years and it will provide necessary safety and operational improvements at the S.R. 434 / Hayes Road intersection.

- **Intersection Safety Improvements at S.R. 419 and Wade Street**

This project consists of construction of eastbound and westbound left-turn deceleration lanes from S.R. 419 onto Wade Street, a right-turn deceleration lane on S.R. 419 westbound onto Wade Street, and reconstruction of Wade Street from S.R. 419 north to the CSX railroad crossing.

Construction Cost: \$362,449
Start Date: Dec. 1, 2009
Finish Date: March 31, 2010

In addition to the federally funded work, the state has approved funding in the amount of up to \$120,000 for construction of a right-turn deceleration lane on S.R. 419 eastbound onto Sherry Avenue. This contract has been awarded to Ranger Construction and is scheduled to start in January 2010. The City recently completed the reconstruction of Wade Street from the CSX railroad crossing to Old Sanford-Oviedo Road.
